EXCELLENCE IN EXPORTS STATE EXPORT AWARD




The coveted shield

PERFORMANCE OF GAS DIVISION

In the first quarter, the group's Gas business recorded an increase of 9.60% in Production and 2% increase in Specific Power Consumption (SPC). The Sales showed a growth of 7.10% increase in Gas and 11% in Liquid business compared to the last quarter.


WORLD EARTH DAY


