Baldota fellowships

Learning tools viz. microscope, geometry kits, globe, charts, science materials, mathematics kit, maps etc. were provided for six schools and 15 anganwadis.

Beyond classrooms


We organized a science exhibition in Hospet that witnessed a participation by 24 schools.


The First Ship Steel Cutting Ceremony at China

For us sustainable business is at the heart of being a sustainable organization. Our foray into the shipping business is a strategic decision to pursue new shores of success. Hence our focus is on becoming a self-sufficient organization that can handle entire iron ore supply chain from raw material production to end use. This will consolidate our present position in the resource market and reinforce the Group's diversification in trading and manufacturing.

Our wholly-owned subsidiary in Singapore namely MSPL Diamond Pte. Ltd. has already contracted the construction of four new dry bulk ships to Taizhou Sanfu Ship Engineering Co. Ltd., China.

The steel cutting ceremony for the first ship was held on October 20, 2009 at a shipyard in China and was inaugurated by Shri Narendrakumar A. Baldota, CMD, MSPL Limited.

These ships have already been registered in advance with the Singapore Registry and are slated for delivery beginning January 2011. Furthermore, the ships have been christened as - Indus Prosperity, Indus Fortune, Indus Triumph & Indus Victory. The names are an amalgam of 'Indus' - derived from Indus valley, the prosperous civilization and flourishing maritime port of ancient times and the four respective suffixes are all synonyms of the word 'success'.





A Fight for Human Rights

Contributions for Anti-trafficking organization - Prajwala

Human trafficking is one of the gravest violations of human rights. The Constitution of India prohibits trafficking in all forms, yet in the name of love, marriage, employment and fame thousands of girls and children are lured into the clutches of this organized crime day in and day out.

Today, however the scenario is changing. Across the country, voices are being raised to address human rights. Eyes are the window to the world and good eyesight is indispensable to live a fulfilling life. At MSPL, our aim is to see a society free from eyesight issues. Towards this we regularly organize free eye check-up camps for our neighbouring communities.

On December 5, 2009, MSPL organized an eye check-up camp at Hanumanahalli school campus in association with Ashwini Eye Hospital - a cataract surgery centre located in Hospet, providing state-of-the-art eye care treatments. The camp undertook a thorough vision check-up to prevent avoidable blindness caused due to cataract.

The camp was inaugurated by Dr. Srinivas V. Deshpande, Ashwini Eye Hospital and witnessed a registration of 200 patients. All of them were screened for eye diseases and 65 patients suffering from cataract were identified. MSPL will ensure that these 65 patients undergo free cataract operation.

Smoke-free Cooking

LPG connection for 72 families of Hanumanahalli and Danapur

Many families in the rural hinterlands continue to depend on wood as a primary source of fuel to cook meals. This not only adds to the problem of deforestation, but also poses a health risk to women of that family.

In the reporting quarter, MSPL provided LPG connection to 72 families in Hanumanahalli and Danapur with the help of Women Self Help Groups. This will be a great boon for the families and ensure a more modern and consistent supply of cooking fuel. It will also ensure that women don't have to go looking for firewood, especially during wet seasons and do not suffer harmful side effects of inhaling smoke during traditional cooking.





The Power of Self-Reliance

By definition self reliance is - dependence on one's own capabilities, judgment or resources. MSPL believes that a progressive and successful society is where women are self-reliant and confident of their capabilities, judgment and ability to garner resources.

The purpose behind the formation of Self Help Groups (SHGs) in our adopted villages was to empower the women with the power of self-reliance.

During the quarter, six SHGs were given financial assistance on a revolving fund basis to further the goals of village development and improve the economic status of women by creating income generation programs.



Helping Women Help Themselves


Empowering women by providing them with income opportunities has also been a part of MSPL's ongoing mission. The route take for this has been through tailoring training. Our six training centres established in six different villages aspire to provide tailoring training for women so that their talent and potential can be realized to the fullest extent; in turn achieving better economic and social development for them. The training program is a comprehensive one, set out to touch upon all aspects of tailoring.

During the quarter, 115 women successfully completed this 6-month training and a further 120 women enrolled for the same. We have also provided free sewing machines to those who have completed their training so that they can practice their learning and make it a profitable profession.

This tailoring training initiative undertaken by MSPL has already started accruing results. The trained women have started earning approx. Rs. 50 to Rs. 200 every day.

Special Classes for our Future Custodians

10th standard exams are a crucial milestone in a student's life, as it determines the course of his or her higher studies. Last year, MSPL organized special classes for 10th standard students to enable them score better and compete with students from urban areas. The feedback was very positive and reassuring. Inspired by the same we organized special classes for 65, 10th standard students at Hanumanahalli and Danapur villages. These classes focused on improving their grasp on English, Maths and Science subjects.

'MSPL's Hasire Usiru' radio program to create environmental awareness

In association with All India Radio (AIR) -Hospet, MSPL initiated the broadcast of 'Hasire Usiru', an infotainment program a few years ago to propagate environmental awareness among school children across the taluka.

This program soon became popular as 'MSPL's Hasire Usiru' and succeeded in orienting young minds to their responsibilities towards mother earth and motivating them to harmonize with nature. To further strengthen the interaction with the children various competitions like drama, essay writing etc are also organized. 

The Baldota Group, Moving Ahead. Proving Its Mettle



The steel industry in India is on an upswing because of strong global and domestic demand. The Baldota Group being the leader in iron ore production has a ready base for producing sufficient amount of steel.

Therefore to expand our business footprint and enhance our profitability, the Group strategically decided to move towards related businesses that sustain growth - the Pellet and Steel production.

Steel Plant



We forayed in to steel production through the launch of Aaress Iron and Steel Limited (AISL). The foundation stone for the greenfield plant was laid on 7th May, 2008 as we decided to set up a 1.2 MTPA Integrated Steel Plant across an area of 1,034 acres at Halavarthi village, Koppal District.

The site development is already underway as we aim to commission the plant by July, 2012. AISL will produce alloy and special long steel products viz. bar and wire rods and has already received offers from various plant units suppliers.

Pellet Plant



We are also setting up a 1.2 MTPA pellet plant under the Group's flagship company MSPL at an investment of Rs. 250 crore. The execution of which has already been initiated in May, 2009.

On the site, the civil work and structural fabrication is near completion and erection of core equipment is under progress.

We aim to procure the remaining equipment by Jan., 2010 and complete the erection work by Feb., 2010. The commissioning of the plant is scheduled by the end of March, 2010.

The steel plant and pellet plant are expected to create direct employment opportunities to close to 1,400 people and indirect employment for many more. These projects will also boost the economy and accelerate development in the backward districts of the state of Karnataka.

Both these business forays will inherit the responsible and sustainable practices that are associated with our Group companies.

Sowing a Greener Future Afforestation Initiatives at MSPL

ENVIRONMEN

Once distributed over half the planet, forests now cover only a quarter of its land surface, upsetting nature's natural equilibrium. To reestablish this balance we need to go green and plant for our planet. Lest we want our children to face the dire consequences of living on a deforested planet.

At MSPL, the seeds of a greener future were sown way back in 1976, as we initiated our tree plantation campaign even when no stringent laws existed. Since then, we have planted over 1.76 million trees, transforming 240 hectares of harsh mining terrain in to a lush landscape.

We kept up a sustained afforestation campaign throughout the year as we planted over 50,000 trees.

As we seek to plant more and more trees, we also emphasize on choosing the right species of trees ones that can collaborate and enhance the local ecosystem. A few of these species are Gulmohar, Neem, Honge, Agaves and Seemthangadi.

We also regularly distribute seeds for kitchen gardens and fruit plant saplings to families in the adopted villages.
