

SHRI. ABHERAJ HIRACHAND BALDOTA 01- 08 -1916 to 29 - 09 - 2005

Shri.Abheraj Hirachand Baldota, eminent industrialist, environmentalist, banker and economist, is considered one of the architects of free India's industrial development and modernisation. Born on August 01, 1916 in Urlikanchan, Dist. of Pune (Maharashtra) to late Shri. Hirachand Mokamdas Baldota and late Smt.Jasodabai Hirachand Baldota, he made the country proud through his stead fast adherence to a vision for his country, which he loved immensely. An Arts Graduate from St. Xavier's College and Law Graduate from Government Law College, Mumbai, he started practicing law in the Mumbai High Court in 1943. He was known as Metal King as his firm Baldota Bros. was the largest importer of non-ferrous metals in India. He subsequently successfully ventured into the industrial arena with the establishment of various industries such as textile, plastic, fire-fighting foam compound and mining.


He was amongst the earliest exponents of free enterprise in India. In 1952, he founded and chaired the Greater Bombay Co-operative Bank Ltd., which is the leading Co-operative Bank in Maharashtra. The Government of Maharashtra had honoured him with the title, "Justice of Peace". He had the distinction of being the Chairman of several institutions during his lifetime such as Bombay Metal Exchange Ltd, Akhil Bhartiya Jain Svetambar Conference. He was also awarded the National Safety Award in 1989 from the hands of the then President of India, Hon'ble Shri. R. Venkatraman. He was the doyen of mining industry.

With his foresight and vision, he has built up a work force known for its dedication and sincerity. Shri. Abheraj H. Baldota was a Gandhian responding to many noble causes and making large donations to various institutions. His interest in the educational field is no less and he laid the foundations of a number of educational institutions. He was a philanthropist always ready to help public causes and ever ready to help anybody in any sphere of life with an enduring smile. He was a multi-faceted personality and a true Gandhian who spread the message of Trusteeship. He was a guide and philosopher to every person who came in his contact. He was a builder of institutions and a great man of vision. Above all, he was a patriot who had enormous courage to stand up for what he firmly believed to be in the interest of the country.

Shri. Abheraj Baldota was known for his innovative and forward thinking initiatives both as an industrialist as well as a philanthropist. In deed the country, on the demise of Shri. Abheraj Baldota, has lost a world ranking and respected entrepreneur possessing immense vision and determined dynamism.

Our salute to the departed legend who has carved the future for the setting up of a very robust value system.






Boldotas Enter Steel Indastry



Baldota Group, an emerging corporate giant in India, with multiple businesses in fields of iron ore mining, exploration of gold and diamonds, industrial and medical gases, wind power generation and banking is entering into steel business.

Mr. Abheraj Baldota, Chairman, Baldota Group of Companies, had a strong desire to forward, integrate and add value to the company's present business of iron ore mining by manufacturing steel. In this endeavor, he had firmed up to locate the steel venture project of the group in the economically backward district of Koppal in Karnataka state.

The proposal of MSPL Limited for setting up a pellet plant of 1.2 MT per annum, Iron and Steel plant of 1.05 Million MT per annum and power plant of 125 MWH using waste heats from Iron making process has been cleared by the Govt. of Karnataka in the High Level Clearance Committee Meeting Chaired by Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri. Dharam Singh. The envisaged investment of the project is Rs.2292.26 Crores, which would generate direct employment for 1000 people and indirect employment for several thousands. The project is scheduled to be commissioned in about two years' period. The company has plans to ramp-up the steel capacity, in phases, to 5 MT per annum in the next 5 years.



FOREST MINISTER'S VISIT


