It was 1961. There were limited resources and no mandatory government stipulations for environmental compliance. Sustainability, therefore, has always formed the core philosophy of the Baldota work culture.

In 1991, FIMI instituted various environment awards to recognize environmental conservation initiatives in the mining industry. One such award is the Abheraj Baldota Environment Award, presented every year to honour the forerunner of environmental stewardship in the mining industry.

On 15th September, 2010, the Abheraj Baldota Environment Award 2009-10 was accorded to the Noamundi Iron Mine at New Delhi for its outstanding contribution towards sustainable development through responsible and holistically sound methodologies.

The Award was presented by Shri B.K. Handique, Hon'ble Union Minister of Mines to Shri D.B. Sundara Raman, the General Manager, OMQ of Noamundi Iron Mine of Tata Steel Ltd.



Operating since 1925, the Noamundi Iron Mine of M/s Tata Steel Ltd. located at West Singbhum district of Jhakhand has been following state-of-the-art practices for mineral conservation and the protection of the mine environment along with rigorously promoting activities for community development.

A first-of-its-kind, the mine is a zero wastewater discharge site. 126 hectares of mined area has been reclaimed and converted into a lush green, dense forest. 18 hectares of mined land has been transformed into a biodiversity park. Solar lights have been installed at multiple locations.

On the societal front, the Noamundi mine actively promotes education, sanitation, healthcare, and income generation activities across 32 villages. Through its Sports Feeder centres, the mine nurtures sporting talent among local children, an endeavour which has been pleasantly effective. It has resulted in the participation of three archers in national championships and has produced an Aruba Awardee, Shri Deepak Mandal in football.

Now with this prestigious acknowledgement, the Noamundi mine, charged more than ever before, is on its way to create even more milestones in the years to come.

With all the rituals duly observed, the Director along with the staff and volunteers of the Group served food to the nearby villagers.



Yashoda, a housewife from Halavarthi village, has also started taking up tailoring jobs with the help of the sewing machine donated to her by MSPL. Apart from this she is also imparting tailoring training to 20 women and supplementing her income with extra tuition fee.

Both these women have chosen a different way of utilizing the training. But they have a common goal of creating a better future for their families.


