## IN SEARCH OF THE YELLOW METAL

The Baldota Group, having established its leadership in Iron Ore Mining, has diversified into Gold Exploration in Karnataka. The Govt. of Karnataka has sanctioned 1233.05 Sq. Km. of area as Reconnaissance Permit (RP) in Gadag Schist-Belt to RMMPL, a unit of the Baldota Group. RMMPL has developed an exploration team under the leadership of Mr. R.H.Sowcar, and Prof. R.P. Viljoen of South Africa, as a consultant. The team has identified three significant lode systems namely Central, Eastern and Western lode and 30 potential target areas classified as hotspots, green field and blue-sky area, based on their potentialities. The detailed exploration work in the identified target areas is in progress in the RP area, which has a number of old workings.




